The Project Management Professional (PMP)[®] is the most important industry-recognized certification for project managers.

As a PMP, you can work in virtually any industry, with any methodology and in any location.

Among survey respondents to PMI's Earning Power Salary Survey, those with a PMP certification garner a higher salary (20% higher on average) than those without a PMP certification according to Earning Power: Project Management Salary Survey Ninth Edition

The PMP signifies that you speak and understand the global language of project management and connects you to a community of professionals, organizations and experts worldwide.

If you're an experienced project manager responsible for all aspects of project delivery, leading and directing cross-functional teams, then the PMP is the right choice for you.

To maintain your PMP, you must earn 60 professional development units (PDUs) every three years.

Project Management Professional Certification (PMP)®

» To be eligible for the PMP® credential, you must meet the following prerequisites as under:

- Secondary degree (high school diploma, associate's degree or the global equivalent)
- 7,500 hours of unique, non-overlapping experience leading and directing projects
- 35 hours of project management education

OR

- Four-year degree
- 4,500 hours of unique, non-overlapping experience leading and directing projects
- 35 hours of project management education

THE PMP® CERTIFICATION PROCESS

» Fulfill Eligibility Criteria

» Complete Application:

- Contact information, Education attained, Domain education
- Domain experience — details of the projects, programs, portfolios you've worked on including qualifying hours, dates of employment, role, organization details, reference, and experience summary

» Application Review: Once the application is submitted, PMI will verify if you meet the eligibility criteria and that your experience and/or education is valid and consistent with the guidelines stated in the certification handbook. This typically takes 5-10 days. When complete, you will receive an email to proceed to the next step

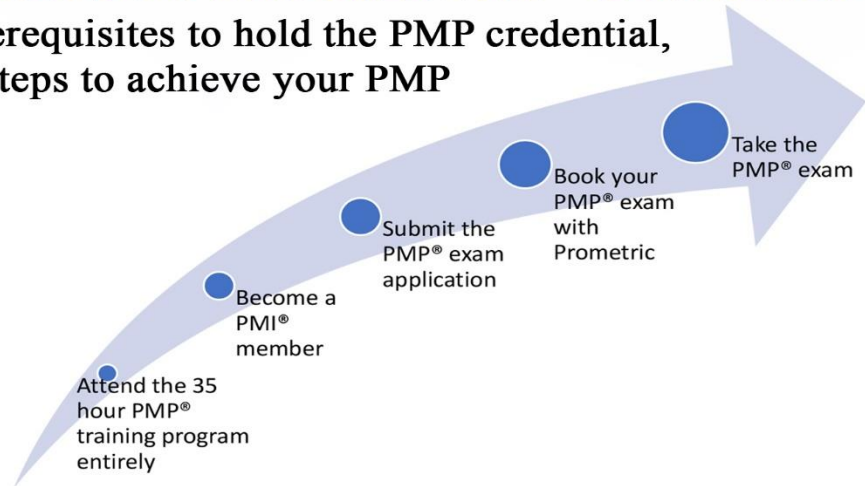
» Audit: PMI conducts application audits to confirm the experience and/or education documented on a specified percentage of randomly selected applications. For more details on the audit, visit: <http://www.pmi.org/certifications/faq>

» Payment: Once payment is received, PMI will email you an eligibility number that you'll use to schedule your test appointment. You are eligible for one year, and you may take the exam up to three times during that year.

If you satisfy the eligibility prerequisites to hold the PMP credential, we recommend the following steps to achieve your PMP credential
